

# Conservation Areas – comment on boundaries and issues facing areas

## *Questionnaire*

The Council has designated 29 Conservation Areas in Bassetlaw District since 1967, and has a programme for reviewing them on a 5 year cycle. The review process will be used to underpin a document called a Conservation Area Appraisal. The Appraisal assesses what is special about the historic and architectural character of each Conservation Area, and provides management proposals that identify what issues are facing the area and what actions are necessary for its preservation or enhancement.

The Council is keen to know your views on Conservation Area boundaries and what issues the areas face in terms of planning, building, social, economic and cultural factors. Specifically, we would like your thoughts on the appropriateness of the existing boundary of each Conservation Area, and what issues you believe should be reflected in the management plan.




