


Description & historic information:

Rectangular remise comprising area of open grassland with tree/hedge belt around the entire boundary, off Park Lane. Early-20th century in date, created to aid hunting. Aldo Leopoldⁱ defines a remise as "a small covert, an acre or two in size, of mixed trees planted just for game". Probably planted for the 6th Duke of Portland.


