
Unregistered Park & Garden: Misson Cemetery

## **Description & historic information:**



Municipal cemetery, earliest burial appears to be August 1899. Rectangular shape with front boundary marked by iron railings (recent) although with the original iron entrance gates. Central path through the site from south to north. Cemetery has a range of significant memorials, including two WW1 graves. Remainder of boundary marked by concrete post and mesh fence. Range of mature trees, including several American Holly towards the front boundary.





Original entrance gates on southern boundary


## Features of significance:

Late-Victorian cemetery, original iron entrance gates, later iron railings, range of significant monuments, several mature trees including American Holly.




