
## Unregistered Park & Garden: Misterton Cemetery



## **Description & historic information:**



Municipal cemetery, off Haxey Road, earliest burial appears to be 1912. Regular grid layout, with brick wall to front boundary with stone copings, iron railings, central gateway, brick and stone gate piers and iron gates. Elsewhere the boundary is marked by hawthorn hedges and regularly spaced sycamore trees. Cemetery contains a variety of significant gravestones and monuments. Site was extended westwards in late-20<sup>th</sup> century.

## Features of significance:

Front boundary wall, railings and gates. Various significant gravestones and monuments, including 2 military graves. Numerous mature trees throughout with boundary hedges.
