Response to Local Development Framework Consultation – December 2010

CS1 – The inclusion of Shireoaks as part of the Worksop settlement is opposed by the Parish Council. It is felt that the village should have its own identity as it has been in existence for so many years and is an established community. There should be definite rural corridors between the village of Rhodesia and the Worksop Town boundary to ensure that Shireoaks retains its own identity.

The inclusion within the Worksop settlement also increases the possibility of housing development figures which would mean further pressure on the current infrastructure.

5.4 Policy DM6 – Gypsies, travellers & travelling show people

The Parish Council would refute the need for the size of the increase in future gypsy/travellers pitches within Bassetlaw.

5.10 Policy DM12 – flood risk

5.33 – In view of current drainage and flooding problems within the village the Parish Council feel that Shireoaks should be included in the list of areas which would require enhancement of the drainage system before any further housing developments are considered.
