Carlton-in-Lindrick Neighbourhood Development Plan – Decision Statement

1 Summary

- 1.1 In accordance with Regulation 18 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Bassetlaw District Council have produced this 'Decision Statement' in relation to the Carlton-in-Lindrick Neighbourhood Development Plan (the 'Plan'), submitted to them by the Parish Council.
- 1.2 Following an independent examination of written representations, Bassetlaw District Council now confirms that the Plan will proceed to a neighbourhood planning referendum.
- 1.3 In accordance with the examiner's recommendations, the Plan will proceed to a public referendum scheduled for the 21st February 2019, based on the Carlton-in-Lindrick Neighbourhood Area, as approved by Bassetlaw District Council on 26th June 2015.
- 1.4 As well as being posted on Bassetlaw District Council's web site, this Decision Statement, along with the independent examiners report can also be viewed on the BDC Neighbourhood Plan website

2 Background

- 2.1 In March 2015, the Parish Council submitted an application to Bassetlaw District Council for the designation of Carlton-in-Lindrick as a Neighbourhood Area. The approval of the Neighbourhood Area Designation for the Carlton-in-Lindrick Neighbourhood Plan was confirmed on 26th June 2015.
- 2.2 The Parish Council completed the Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan for Carlton-in-Lindrick on the 19th February 2018.
- 2.3 The Submission version of the Neighbourhood Plan was completed in July 2018 and submitted to the Council on 16th July 2018; Bassetlaw District Council held an 8-week consultation period, ending on the 9th September 2018.
- 2.4 An Independent Examiner was appointed to undertake the examination of the Submission version of the Neighbourhood Plan and this was completed with the examination report sent to both the Parish Council and District Council in late November 2018.

3 Decisions and Reasons

- 3.1 Following the approval of Full Council, the Head of Economic Development, in consultation with the Council's Cabinet Member for Economic Development has determined that all the recommended modifications set out in the Examiners Report will be undertaken to ensure that the Plan meets the Basic Conditions.
- 3.2 The Examiner has concluded that, with the specified modifications, the Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other relevant legal requirements. The Council concurs with this view. Therefore, to meet the requirements of the Localism Act 2011, a referendum which poses the question ***“Do you want Bassetlaw District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Carlton-in-Lindrick to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”*** will be held in the Carlton-in-Lindrick Neighbourhood Area on 21st February 2019.
