


Figure 4.1.2: Bevercotes National Landscape Character






Figure 4.1.3: Bevercotes District Landscape Character





Figure 4.1.5: Bevercotes Landscape Context

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


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Figure 4.1.7: Bevercotes Landscape Analysis

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




Figure 4.1.10: Gamston National Landscape Character






Figure 4.1.11: Gamston District Landscape Character




Figure 4.1.13: Gamston Landscape Context





Figure 4.1.15: Gamston Landscape Analysis

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
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Figure 4.1.22: Land East of Carlton-in-Lindrick Viewpoints and Visibility

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





Figure 4.3.1 Bevercotes Master Plan - Environmental Analysis










Figures 4.3.2 Bevercotes Master Plan 2 - Masterplan Evolution - Ebenezer Howard Strategy













Figures 4.3.6: Gamston Masterplan – Environ	mental Analysis







Figures 4.3.10: Gamston Masterplan – Defined Masterplan






Figures 4.3.11: Combined Masterplan
