Re: Application to designate a Neighbourhood Plan boundary

Dear Will,
Following a Public Meeting held on 16.07.19 to consider the need for a Neighbourhood Plan, East Drayton Parish Council (the relevant body) hereby applies for the establishment of a Neighbourhood Area to be known as the "East Drayton Neighbourhood Plan". The area for the proposed Neighbourhood Plan is the Parish Boundary as shown on the attached OS map. The proposed area covers the whole of a single parish boundary area.

Upon designation, it is intended to create a Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG), a sub-committee to East Drayton Parish Council, with a mix of residents and parish councillors. Representatives from the NPSG will attend Parish Council meetings to provide updates on the progress of the Plan.

The intention of the NPSG will be to develop a Neighbourhood Plan so that residents will have greater involvement and influence over the future vision of the village of East Drayton. The Parish Council also wishes to ensure that any future planning and development of the village is supported with the correct and necessary infrastructure.

East Drayton is a small village with a population of less than 250 which has its roots in the farming community but has changed over the last three decades with the redevelopment of many of the farms into residential properties.

East Drayton is positioned approximately 9 miles east of Retford and 15 miles west of Lincoln. The village is set out on four roads, Top Street, Low Street, Church Lane and North Green meeting at a cross roads on which is centred the Anglican church of St Peter.

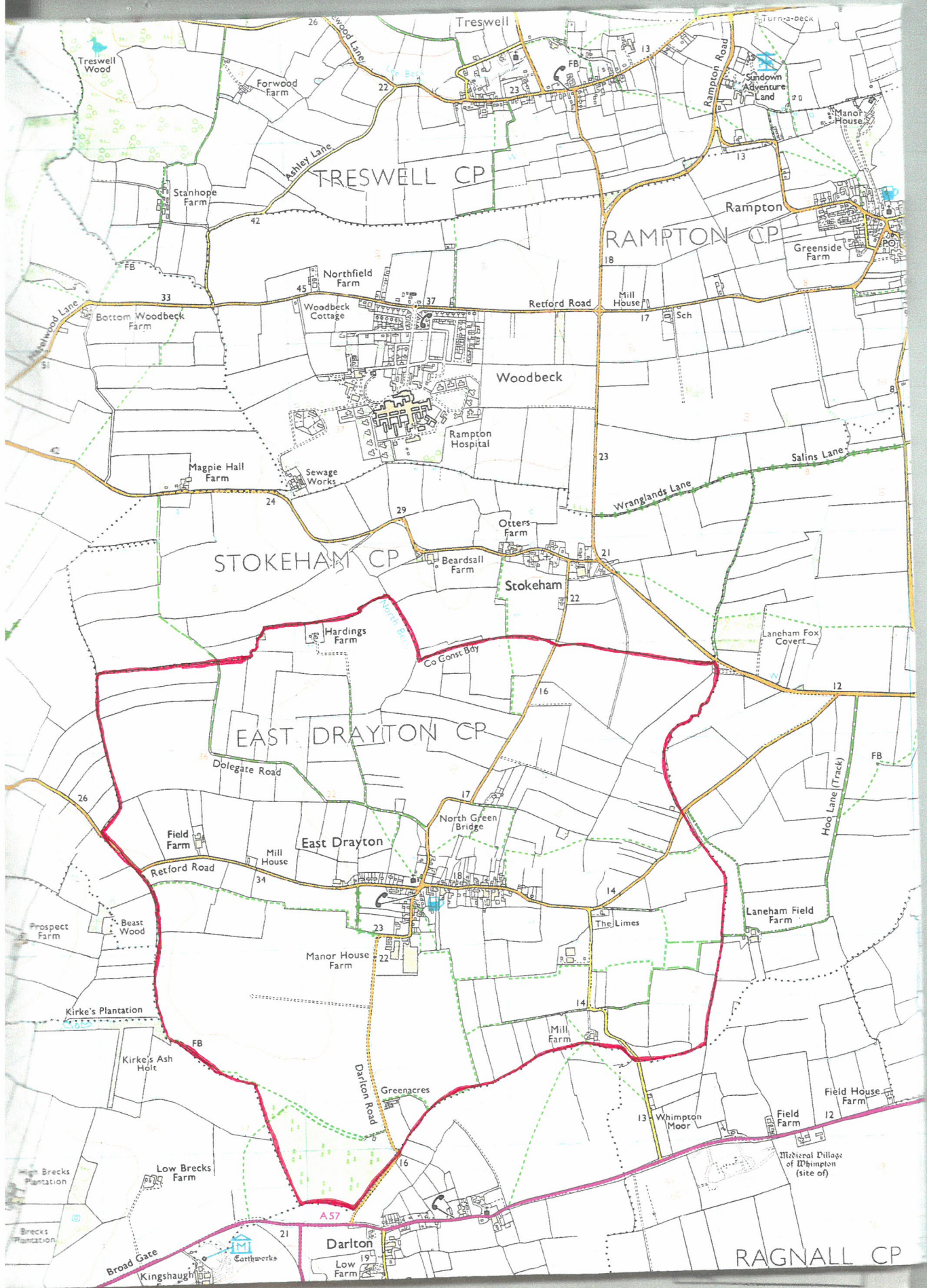


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EAST DRAYTON PARISH BOUNDARY
