


## The Draft Bassetlaw Plan: Spatial Strategy: Worksop

## Worksop Town Centre

Worksop's role as a key retail, leisure and entertainment hub, can be enhanced by:





Creating a Central Worksop Development Plan Document that will enhance the town centre's public realm, links to the Chesterfield Canal, improve traffic movement and accessibility, create open and green spaces, and ensure the area becomes a more attractive place to live, work and visit.



Bridge Street and the Priory Shopping
Centre will continue to be the focus of retail
activity, while the impact of any proposed
'out of town' retail development will be
carefully considered.
