

The Draft Bassetlaw Plan: Spatial Strategy: Employment

At least **11,200** JOBS need to be created in **Bassetlaw BY 2037**

The District will have a diverse and thriving economy with Worksop, Retford, Harworth and Bircotes and Large Rural Settlements acting as employment and service centres for their surrounding rural areas.

The economy will provide access to higher skilled, better paid jobs making the District an ideal place in which to work and live. It will also enable and support the growth of small local businesses and large enterprises alike.

> Bassetlaw will increase its appeal as a tourist destination, which will in turn boost the visitor economy.

This will require the **development of 168 HECTARES** of employment land



As well as a LARGE SCALE SITE at Apleyhead close to transport links such as the A57 and THE A1
