1.0 Bassetlaw GTAA information: Implications of potential Land Supply on meeting need identified in 2019 GTAA

1.1 The revised needs with the period 2034-2038 (an additional year to match the plan period) is:

- PPTS: 9
- Ethnic: 12

1.2 This results in an increase for the full plan period of 2019-2038:

- PPTS: 42
- Ethnic: 55

1.3 Since the GTAA, 1 pitch has been granted planning permission. In relation to the first ten years of the plan period (2019 – 2029), this results in the following:

- PPTS: 20
- Ethnic: 29

1.4 In relation to formalising sites and meeting need for the first 10 years (2019 - 2029):

- Brough Lane, Elkesley: 9 pitches
- North Blyth: 4 pitches
- Hayton: 10 pitches

1.5 This equates to potential identified land supply for a potential 23 pitches.

1.6 In addition to the above, we suggest that the council continue working with families on existing sites and on any newly developed unauthorised developments in meeting their respective accommodation needs. This need could be met through windfall applications.
