Examination in Public

The Bassetlaw Local Plan will be subject to an independent examination to be conducted by the Planning Inspectorate. This is a continuous process running from the date of submission through to the receipt of the appointed Planning Inspector's Report. The examination process is now under the Planning Inspectorate's control.

The appointed Inspector will examine if the Bassetlaw Local Plan meets the tests of soundness defined in the National Planning Policy Framework and meets relevant legislative requirements. The Inspector will review representations previously made on the document and will consider local evidence. The examination process may involve hearing sessions where those invited to attend will have the opportunity to respond to matters raised by the Inspector.

Please note, this is not an opportunity to make further representations regarding the Bassetlaw Local Plan. Those who made representations on the plan will, if the Inspector deems it appropriate, be offered the opportunity to appear at the examination and will be notified about the examination process by the Programme Officer.

Programme Officer
