4.4 These policies need to be set more broadly so that settlements currently wedged into the Settlement Hierarchy as large villages, in the west (Carlton Lindrick et al), can develop using Regeneration policies. At present, they masquerade as Rural Service Centres – which they are not. Please see attached. Removing these settlements (Misterton, Blyth, Carlton etc) from the hierarchy will allow a NEW settlement hierarchy to be drawn – and one that is properly SPATIAL – that includes CURRENT Rural Service Centres and allows them to evolve.
