- 1. What is the justification for the safeguarding the land identified in policy ST56?
 - Is this supported by up to date evidence?
 - Why does the Council propose to remove some of the land proposed for safeguarding from the plan? Is this justified?
 - Should the policy make provision for possible future improvements to the A1?
 - Should the policy and supporting text refer to Sec 278 agreements?
- 2. Are the suggested modifications to Policy ST57 justified and necessary for soundness?
- 3. Are the requirements of Policy ST58 clear, justified and consistent with national policy? Would they be effective?

 - Would this approach adequately address the cumulative impacts of development?
 - Is the requirement to provide proportionate contributions on a retrospective basis clear? What is the justification for this? Would it be effective?
 - Is sufficient clarity provided with regard to the review mechanism?
 - Is the policy sufficiently flexible?
 - Are there any omissions from the proposed policy and supporting text?
 - Are the suggested main modifications to the supporting text necessary for soundness?
- 4. Is the plan sufficiently clear as to how its implementation will be monitored? Are the Council's modifications necessary for soundness?
