NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA DESIGNATION REQUEST: GRINGLEY ON THE HILL

Following a Parish Council Meeting held on 24 May 2023 to consider the need for a Neighbourhood Plan, Gringley on the Hill Parish Council (the relevant body) hereby applies for the designation of a new Neighbourhood Area, to be known as Gringley on the Hill. The boundary of the proposed Neighbourhood Area matches that of the Parish, as detailed on the attached map. Gringley on the Hill Parish Council considers that this proposal accords with the requirements of section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Subject to designation by the District Council, it is proposed that a Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG) will be established to progress the development of the Neighbourhood Plan. The Steering Group will act as a sub committee to Gringley on the Hill Parish Council, with membership open to both residents and parish councillors. Representatives from the NPSG will attend Parish Council meetings to provide updates on the progress of the Plan as required.

The intention of the NPSG will be to develop a Neighbourhood Plan so that residents will have greater involvement and influence over the future vision of the Parish. The Parish Council also wishes to ensure that any future planning and development of the village is supported with the correct and necessary infrastructure.
