

2. Descriptions

1. From Pasture Hill Farm (Grade II Listed Building), west across open countryside with field ponds and other habitat sites back towards Nether Langwith. This is an important 'village setting' view from public footpaths FP5 and 6



2. From Blue Barn Farm on footpath FP3 southwest over open countryside to Nether Langwith; this view characterises the north half of the Plan Area and contributes to the 'sense of place' of the village



3. From Cockshut Lane at the junction of footpath FP2 northeast toward Graves Wood. This is a popular dog-walking route for residents in the north part of the village



4. From the drive to Langwith Lodge looking back west-northwest across the candidate protected wildlife area/open space toward Welfitt Grove and the village; currently it is managed as a wildflower/hay meadow



5. The iconic 'postcard' view of Nether Langwith, with Queens Walk and one of the courses of the River Poulter through the village. This is the historic core of the original medieval village, and part of the Conservation Area.
