We wish to avail you of a recent petition gathered from people in or that frequent the town of Retford and to share with you an online petition <u>Change.org · The world's platform for change</u>, both regarding the above subject.

We kindly ask that these are taken into consideration with BDC's recent 'consultation' regarding Retford's Markets Proposal which the signatories wish to see halted and at least reviewed.

Market traders and many local businesses feel they have had zero consultation before the proposals were seen online, and many residents and visitors to our town do not want to see the wonderful Market Square and glorious War Memorial blighted by almost permanently positioned stalls, which many believe will attract anti-social behaviour.
