Notice of intention to commence local plan preparation

Bassetlaw District Council gives notice of its intention to commence the preparation of a new local plan in accordance with Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2026, Part 4, Regulation 19.

The title of the local plan is, the Bassetlaw Local Plan 2026-2045 and it will cover the administrative area of Bassetlaw District. The local plan area is shown on the map below.

The Bassetlaw Local Plan will set out a spatial planning and policy framework for the period 2026-2045. It will include a long-term vision and strategic objectives, a spatial strategy, local policy framework and a monitoring and implementation framework to deliver the strategy.

Minerals and waste planning matters will be addressed separately by Nottinghamshire County Council as the Minerals and Waste Authority for Bassetlaw.



The Council intend to start the formal 30 month plan-making process on 30 October 2026.
